### **Additional funding information**

For the 30 hours of funding from the beginning of September, the child would be eligible for 1140 hours of funded hours (38 weeks of funding). Therefore, families receive a maximum of 22.8 hours per week for the 30 hours of funded childcare. Please note if your child joins us later than the start of the academic year or becomes eligible for funded hours during the academic year, the funded weeks entitled to may be less than 38 weeks, and your total funded hours for the year may be different. Please speak to the school office who can calculate the funded hours for you.

### **Agreed Essentials and Extras Charge:**

We take pride in offering exceptional provision for the Early Years Foundation Stage; the local authority funding rate set by DfE is only intended to cover the minimum requirements of the EYFS.

The optional agreed essentials and extras charge covers the following items:

**Essentials:** Disposable childcare items. Additional arts and craft equipment/supplies (outside the minimum EYFS requirements) will also be provided. This provision, therefore, requires funding beyond that offered by the Early Years Funding to ensure we can deliver exceptional service and care. Please note these are calculated on average.

**Extras:** our provision also includes subject specialist teaching, including Drama, Forest School, Music, Early Phonics/Reading, PE, Dance, and Languages. In addition, the children have access to a Sports Hall, Pre-Prep Hall for Preschool PE lessons, Preschool Outdoor Classroom Lessons, access to the school field, school tennis courts, school library, and an outdoor classroom area for all children. On top of the Nursery's playground, outside spaces, library, art rooms, ICT room, and sensory room (all dependent on the day that your child attends).

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
