Children at The Chadderton Preparatory Grammar take part in the End of Key Stage 2 (Year 6) SATs and also take part in optional testing in Years 1, 2, 3 and 4. The Chadderton Preparatory Grammar is completely non-selective, which makes our academic success more pleasing.

By the end of Key Stage 2 national expectations for 2014-2015 were for children to have reached Level 4. Level 5 is a great achievement in KS2 SATs and shows the child is working at a high level.

During the academic year 2015-2016, levels were removed and replaced with children meeting age related expectations or children not meeting age related expectations.
